This is our budget for 2018, which shows that we expect to make a loss of around £12,000. This is in part due to increased Parish Share to pay for our Rector, and for Diocesan overheads.

Some facts of life

Our members average weekly giving is £7.35, with single people giving 50p more per person than married couples.

In our deanery the average weekly giving is £9.50
