### **Town Hall and Richmondshire Museum historical talks, 5<sup>th</sup> July, by Jane Hatcher and Bob Woodings.**

Local historian Jane Hatcher will be giving a talk at the Town Hall on Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> July at 7pm. The subject is: 'Richmond Remembers' - a recording of a BBC programme made in 1985 about a set of photographs taken of Richmond in 1945 by the British Council.
