residential community based in Thirsk, offering a genuine welcome to individuals and groups throughout the year. People might choose to come for a short break or to help avoid a crisis. For some people this is where the mask can come off, where mental health, anxiety or depression can be named and known. Holy Rood can be the place to come to when everything feels a bit too much. Their confidential counselling service is accessible to local people, and some who come from further afield.
