In the financial year 2022/23, the charity supported over 66,000 people through its nursing services, hospices and support line calls. The charity runs dedicated Hospices and its information and support service is used more than 1.2 million times per year. Marie Curie is the largest charitable UK funder of palliative and end of life care research.
