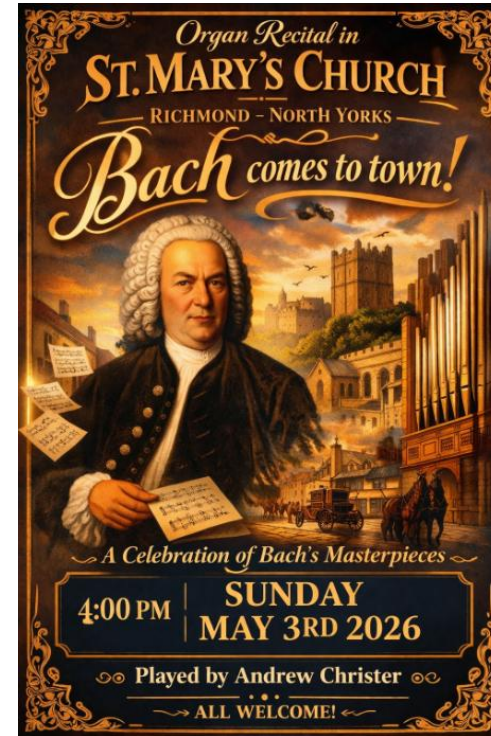
## The April Charity of the Month: Assistance Dogs
