St Mary's Prayer Circle for Confidential Prayers

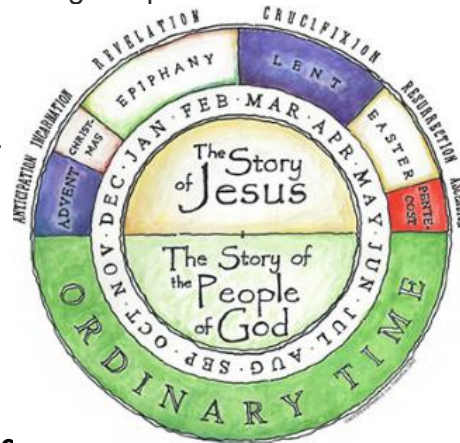
