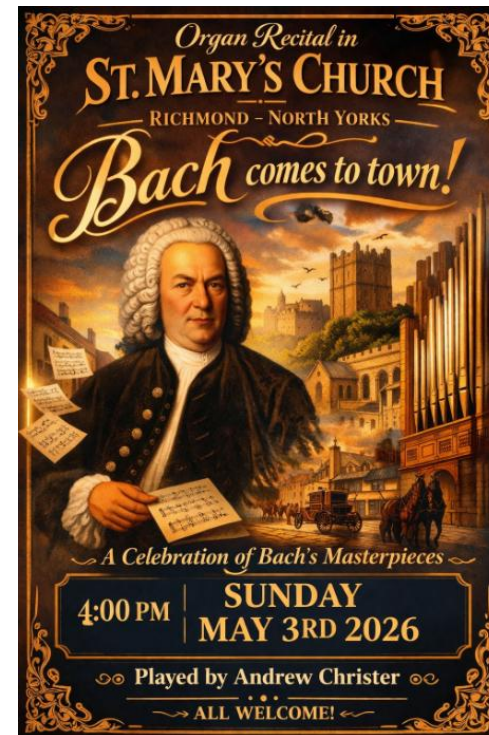


The May Charity of the Month is Christian Aid:
