

# EASTER TRAIL

**You are invited to take part in our Easter Trail around the churches in Richmond. There are 8 scenes from the Easter Story and something to look out for in each one.**

**Scene 1 – Roman Catholic Church Palm Sunday**  
 They brought the colt to Jesus. They threw their coats over it. Then he sat on it. Many people spread their coats on the road. Others spread branches they had cut in the fields.  
 Mark 11:7-8

Jesus rode a donkey to Jerusalem

The crowd waved palms.

**Scene 3 – Influence Church Last Supper**  
 While they were eating, Jesus took bread. He gave thanks and broke it. He handed it to his disciples and said, "Take it. This is my body." Mark 14:22

**Scene 4 – Influence Church Prayer at Gethsemane**  
 "Abba, Father," he said, "everything is possible for you. Take this cup of suffering away from me. But let what you want be done, not what I want." Mark 14:36

Jesus turned over the tables in the Temple

Jesus and his friends ate a Last Supper together

Jesus prayed, "let what you want be done."



**Scene 2 – Roman Catholic Church Cleansing of the Temple**  
 When they arrived back in Jerusalem, Jesus entered the Temple and began to drive out the people buying and selling animals for sacrifices. He knocked over the tables of the money changers and the chairs of those selling doves, and he stopped everyone from using the Temple as a marketplace. He said to them, "The Scriptures declare, 'My Temple will be called a house of prayer for all nations,' but you have turned it into a den of thieves."  
 Mark 11:15-17

Jesus was tried

Jesus died on the cross

**Scene 5 – Methodist Church Jesus' trial**  
 The leading priests and the entire high council were trying to find evidence against Jesus, so they could put him to death. But they couldn't find any. Mark 14:55

**Scene 6 – Methodist Church Crucifixion**  
 With a loud cry, Jesus took his last breath. Mark 15:37

The angel said, "He isn't here! He is risen!"

**Scene 7 – St Mary's Church Resurrection**  
 When they entered the tomb, they saw a young man clothed in a white robe sitting on the right side. The women were shocked, but the angel said, "Don't be alarmed. You are looking for Jesus of Nazareth, who was crucified. He isn't here! He is risen from the dead! Look, this is where they laid his body."  
 Mark 16:5-6
